

SUBJECT: NOTICE REQUIRED BY ARTICLE 13 OF ITALIAN LEGISLATIVE DECREE 196/2003

Italian Legislative Decree 196 of 30 June 2003 (“Code for the protection of personal information”) protects the personal information of persons and other subjects.

According to this law, information must be handled in a correct, legal and transparent manner and in such a way as to protect your confidentiality and rights.

Therefore, in conformity with article 13 of Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003, we would like to inform you that:

1. The information provided by you, or obtained from other sources, in observance of current legislative and contractual provisions, will be used for the correct and complete fulfilment of our commercial relationship and our obligations under Italian and Community law and regulations as well as other provisions issued by the proper authorities.

2. The information will be handled primarily by computer and stored on magnetic, paper or other suitable media, in observance of the minimum security measures required by the Technical Regulation on the subject of minimum security, Attachment B of Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003.

3. Providing the information is optional although a refusal to do so could make it impossible to pursue the relationship.

4. The information will not be circulated. The information may only be communicated to the following subjects:

- employees assigned to handle it;
- professional offices, consultants, data processing companies, statistical companies and auditing companies, for handling related to administrative, accounting and management obligations involved in the ordinary operations of a business and the fulfilment of fiscal responsibilities;
- credit institutions, insurance companies and brokerage companies for financial management and for the fulfilment of contractual obligations towards you;
- professional offices, leasing and factoring companies, collection agencies and legal consultants for credit collection and fraud control;
- Public Authorities and the Public Administration for the fulfilment of legal obligations.

7. You may contact the owner, for handling purposes, at any time to exercise your rights under article 7 of Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003, which we reproduce here for your convenience:

Article 7 of Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003

Right of access to personal information and other rights

1. The party concerned has a right to know whether or not personal information about him/her exists, even if not yet recorded, and to receive a copy in intelligible form.

2. The party concerned has the right to know:

- a) where the personal information came from;

- b) how and why it will be used;
 - c) the processing logic applied, in the case it is handled by computer;
 - d) contact information for the owner, manager and representatives designated in conformity with article 5, paragraph 2;
 - e) the subjects, or categories of subjects, to whom the personal information may be given or that may come to know it in their capacity as designated representative in the country or as managers or assignees:
3. The party concerned has the right to have:
- a) the information updated, corrected and, when there is an interest, supplemented;
 - b) the information deleted, made anonymous or blocked from use in violation of the law, including any information that is not necessary for conservation in terms of the purposes for which the information was collected or subsequently handled;
 - c) certification that the operations referred to in letters "a" and "b" have also been brought to the attention of those to whom the information was given or circulated, except where it is impossible or requires an effort that is clearly disproportionate to the right being protected.
4. The party concerned has a right to oppose, in whole or in part:
- a) the use of personal information that regards him/her, for legitimate reasons, even though pertinent to the purpose for which it was collected;
 - b) the handling of personal information that regards him/her for sending advertising material, direct sales, market research, or commercial communications.
