

## **PRIVACY POLICY**

Terexlift S.r.l. wishes to inform you how your personal surfing data and any data you may voluntarily provide as a user of the website at [www.terexlift.it](http://www.terexlift.it) will be handled and managed.

This notice refers only to the Terexlift S.r.l website and not to other websites you may link to.

This notice is provided in conformity with article 13 of Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003, and is also inspired by Recommendation 2/2001 that the European authorities for the protection of personal information, united in the groups established by article 29 of Directive 95/46/EC, adopted on 17 May 2001 to identify several minimum requirements for the collection of personal information on-line, which the owners, for handling purposes, must provide users when they connect to a web page, regardless of the purposes for which they connected.

### **\_ OWNER FOR HANDLING PURPOSES**

The owner, for handling purposes, is TEREXLIFT S.r.l. with headquarters in Umbertide, Zona Industriale Buzzacchero 06019 – Perugia (Italy). The manager, for handling purposes, is Lucio Maranga.

### **\_ PURPOSE OF USE AND TYPES OF INFORMATION HANDLED**

a) The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mail to the addresses listed in the site involves acquiring the sender's e-mail address and any other information provided in the message. This information will only be used to provide the requested service.

b) The use of communications protocols involves the implicit transmission of data that the website's software applications and computer systems acquire for their operation. This information is not collected for association to identified persons but could lead to the identification of the user when processed and associated with information held by third parties. This information includes IP addresses or domain names of the computer that the user used to connect to the site; the addresses in the URLs of the requested resources; the time of the request; the method used to submit the request to the server; the size of the file obtained in response; the code number indicating the status of the server's response (success, error, etc.) and other parameters of the user's operating system and computer environment. The above information is used to check the correct operation of the site as well as to prepare website usage statistics. The data could be used to determine responsibility in the event that the site were damaged by a hypothetical computer crime.

### **\_ METHOD AND PLACE OF HANDLING**

The information will be handled with and/or without the use of computers.

The information will be used for the amount of time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which it was collected.

Suitable security measures have been provided to prevent the loss of the data, its illegal or incorrect use and unauthorized accesses.

The information is handled at the legal offices of Terexlift S.r.l.

No information derived from the website will be circulated.

## **\_ PROVIDING THE INFORMATION**

Keeping in mind what was mentioned above about surfing data, the information you provide when sending e-mail is optional.

However, failure to provide the data may make it impossible to obtain the requested service or information.

## **\_ COOKIES**

Cookies are not used to send information of a personal nature nor do we use persistent cookies or user-tracking systems.

We use session cookies that are not permanently stored on your computer and are deleted when you close your browser. Their use is strictly limited to the transmission of the session identifiers needed for secure and efficient site browsing.

## **\_ THE RIGHTS OF CONCERNED PARTIES**

1. You have a right to know whether or not personal information about you exists, even if not yet recorded, and to receive a copy in intelligible form.
2. You have the right to know: a) where the personal information came from; b) how and why it will be used; c) the processing logic applied, in the case it is handled by computer; d) contact information for the owner, manager and representatives designated in conformity with article 5, paragraph 2; e) the subjects, or categories of subjects, to whom your personal information may be given or that may come to know it in their capacity as designated representative in the country or as managers or assignees.
3. You have the right to have: a) the information updated, corrected and, when there is an interest, supplemented; b) the information deleted, made anonymous or blocked from use in violation of the law, including any information that is not necessary for conservation in terms of the purposes for which the information was collected or subsequently handled; c) certification that the operations referred to in letters "a" and "b" have also been brought to the attention of those to whom the information was given or circulated, except where it is impossible or requires an effort that is clearly disproportionate to the right being protected.
4. You have a right to oppose, in whole or in part: a) the use of your personal information, for legitimate reasons, even though pertinent to the purpose for which it was collected; b) the handling of your personal information for sending advertising material, direct sales, market research or commercial communications.
